1. Course Structure:

- *Lecture Week:* starts on a Friday. So week 0 is just last Wednesday and today. Assignments are released every Wednesday and the deadline is one week later on Tuesday at 23:59.
- *Assignments:* Two types, written assignments that you can find on the website and quizzes on Moodle.
- *Hand-In:* You can upload your solution for the first question in each week's assignment marked as Hand-In on Moodle. I see your solution and give you feedback. To receive feedback you should upload your solution before the deadline.
- *Bonus Points:* You receive bonus points for bonus-quizzes on Moodle and for some written tasks. The result of the 10 out of the 12 best bonus questions along the semester can win you +0.25 points for your final grade. You get 3 tries for each bonus-quiz on Moodle and the deadline is at the end of the current lecture week. The bonus-quizzes are auto-graded, but you have to hand in the written bonus questions to receive points.
